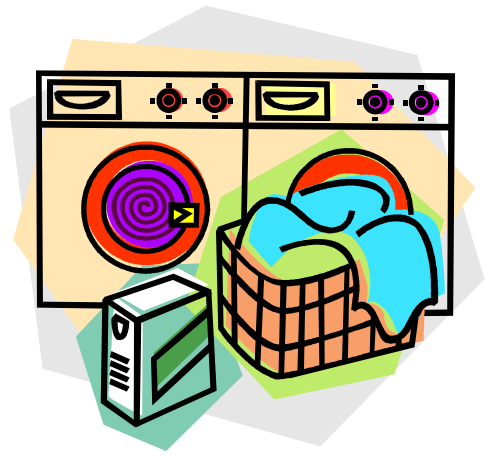


## **Material Aid and Support Services**

Make sure that you ring for an appointment before landing on their doorstep, or you may be turned away. Note services require healthcare card as ID; you may have to live in their catchment area to access the service.

If you are homeless or in crisis accommodation they may waive their policy around catchment.

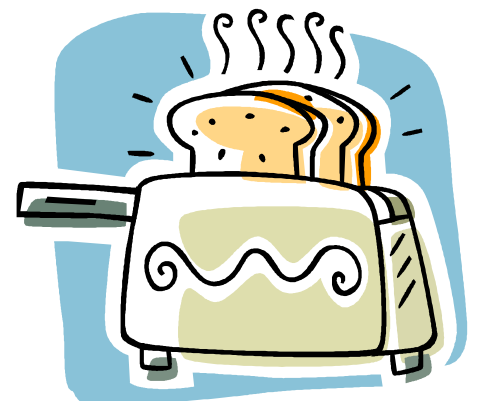
